

## PREVENTATIVE MAINTENANCE SCHEDULE

## **AIR CONDITIONING / PREVENTATIVE MAINTENANCE**

## ITEMS CHECKED

Clean Condensers	_Clean condenser coils with, chemicals and power sprayer, reverse air flow
Clean Evaporator Coils	_Clean condenser coils with, chemicals and power sprayer, reverse air flow
Check All Electrical	_Check for frayed, cut or damaged cords, contactors, tight, burning or pitting
Replace Belts	_Replace belts and store old belts inside unit
Check All Pulleys	_Check for tightness and visible damage
Check All Bearings	_Check for drag and free spinning
Check Blower Motor	_ Check for visible damage and vibration
Check Squirrel Cages	_Check for visible damage
Check Thermostats	_ Check for proper operation and check all connections
Condensers Fan Operation	_Check for visible damage, does it turn freely
Replace Air Filters	_Replace all a/c filters in store and initial filters
Clean All Drains	_Clean out all drains and check ( must be solid and secure to drain drop )
Check Airflow	_Check for proper airflow once unit is running
Check Room Temperature	_ Check room temperature once unit is running
Clean All Condenser Coils	_Clean all coils on roof, ice makers, walk-in cooler / freezer
Clean Roof	_Clean and wash down the whole roof and remove all debris
Clean Roof Drains	_Clean and wash out the roof drains
Replace All Missing Screws	_Replace any missing screws on any units on the roof
Check safety lighting	_Check out the operation of safety lighting
Check Exit Signs	_Check all exit signs for lighting
Check Roof Vents	_ Check clean and fix any damage to all roof vents and replace all belts
Check Temperature Split	_Check return and supply temperature for the split
