



PREVENTATIVE MAINTENANCE SCHEDULE

SODA FOUNTAIN & ICE MAKERS / PREVENTATIVE MAINTENANCE

ITEMS CHECKED

<u>Check Power Cables</u>	Check for frayed, cut, or damaged cords or power supply
<u>Clean Water Supply</u>	Check for leaks, cracks or damage to lines
<u>Check All Drain Lines</u>	Make sure all drain lines are open, and unclogged as necessary
<u>Clean Inlet Tubes</u>	Make sure all tubes are free of any restrictions and clean
<u>Clean Strainers</u>	Clean out all strainers
<u>Clean Distribution Tubes</u>	Clean out all distribution tubes
<u>Clean Cups</u>	Clean out all cups
<u>Check Water Probe</u>	Check for any damage
<u>Check Evaporator Probe</u>	Check for any damage
<u>Check Bin Probe</u>	Check for any damage
<u>Check Water Pump</u>	Check for cracks, leaks and damage
<u>Check Blades & Screens</u>	Check to make sure all are in good condition and clean
<u>Check Water / Ice Plates</u>	Check for damage and wear
<u>Check Drain Pan</u>	Check for cracks and or damage
<u>Check Cycle Time</u>	Make sure cycle times is not damaged and works correctly
<u>Replace All Water Filters</u>	Replace all water filters every 6 months
<u>Check Remote Condenser</u>	Check remote condenser for damage and that it works properly w/o leaks
<u>Check CO2 Lines And Tanks</u>	Check for ice on the CO2 tank, if so, check all lines for leaks
<u>Check Water Pressure</u>	Water pressure needs to be 60 PSIG to 80 PSIG
<u>Check Carbonators</u>	Check for cycling, water leaks
<u>Check BIB, Syrup Pumps, Lines</u>	Check for any type of leaks
<u>Clean and Brix Valves</u>	See pocket brixing ratio card for all products
